

HELMET SPECIFICATIONS

The Australian National Drag Racing Association (ANDRA) specifies that ALL helmets must currently meet one of the following standards:

AS/NZS 1698 (AS/NZS 1698:2006).
SNELL SA2000, SA2005, SA2010, SFI 31.2A.
SNELL M2000, M2005, M2010, SFI 41.2A.
BS 6658-1985.

One of these standards must be located on/inside your helmet.

Helmets labelled AS 1698 are no longer recognised by Standards Australia for motor sport activities and therefore will *not* pass scrutineering and cannot be used for drag racing.

As of 1.8.2010 the use of open face helmets are prohibited on motorcycles.

SNELL M2000 & SNELL SA2000 will not be permitted as of 1.8.2011.

Helmets will only be accepted for 12 years from date of manufacture or Standards approval date.
